 - 1. By becoming the Word Vs. 18, (John 1:1-2)
 - 2. By completing the law (Romans 10:4)
 - 3. He fulfilled all the O.T. predictions about himself.
 - 4. He fulfilled the law by living a sinless life.
 - 5. He fulfilled the law by His teaching.

 - 2. It is credited to us by faith in Christ (Phil. 3:9)
 - 3. It is worked in us by the Holy Spirit (Matt. 5:20)
